# Holy Land 2012

## 31 Oct (W) – Depart USA

Depart on your international overnight flight from the United States.

## 01 Nov (H) – Arrive in Tel Aviv / Netanya

Our representatives will greet you at the airport and transfer you to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

## 02 Nov (F) – Caesarea / Haifa / Mount Carmel / Megiddo / Nazareth Village / Tiberias

Begin your time in Israel by driving along the Mediterranean to **Caesarea Maritime**. Herod the Great built this port city in tribute to Rome, and here Peter and Paul witnessed to Christ's Resurrection. Wonder at the **Roman Aqueduct and Theatre**, as well as the crusader fortress built from Roman and Byzantine stone. In **Haifa**, we'll stop at the offices of Archbishop Chacour, the founder of the **Ibillin School** that unites Arab and Jewish children together in learning. Look out over the Valley of Jezreel from the heights of **Mount Carmel**.

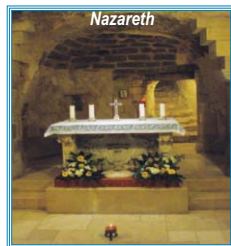
On this mount, Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). We'll head south and inland to **Megiddo** on the plains of Armageddon. Here Solomon and other

Israeli kings had a major center for commerce and military protection. Explore the

### Nazareth Village,

a living presentation of the life, times, and teachings of Jesus of Nazareth.

Finish the day at your hotel in the Galilee.



## 03 Nov (S) – Sea of Galilee & Beit Shean

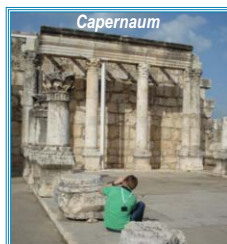
With Bible in hand, cross the waters of the **Sea of Galilee** aboard a Kinnereth Sailing Company boat.

Along the way, participate in a special on board worship service. Travel to **Capernaum**, the



center of Jesus' ministry in the Galilee. Visit the synagogue which stands on the site where Jesus taught. Recall his teaching and preaching the gospel of the kingdom (Matt.4: 13, 23). At

**Kibbutz Nof Ginnosar**, you'll learn about the "Ancient Boat", a rare example of the kind of boat in which Jesus would have sailed. Travel to the **Mount of Beatitudes** where Jesus preached to the people (Matt. 5-7). At



**Tabgha**, the traditional location for the calling of the disciples and the feeding of the 5000, you'll visit the **Church of the Fish and the Loaves** (Luke 9:10-17).

You'll also visit the **Chapel of the Primacy** where three times Peter professed his devotion to the risen Christ (John 21). Walk the colonnaded streets of **Beit Shean**, a city continuously inhabited for over 5,000 years. Here Saul and his son's bodies were hung from the walls of the city (1 Samuel 31). The uncovered ruins date back to the Greek / Roman city that was part of the Decapolis of Jesus' day. At the **River Jordan** you can remember your baptism in the **Yardenit Baptismal Site**.

## 04 Nov (U) – Gideon's Spring / Jenin / Jordan Valley / Jericho / Dead Sea

Begin your Sunday with a visit to **Gideon's Spring** (Ein Harod). Here Gideon chose his army of 300 by observing how they drank from the springs (Judges 7).

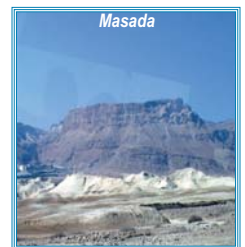
Pass through **Jezreel Valley** to the village of **Jenin**, where you will interact with local Palestinians. Pass through the Jordan Valley to **Jericho**. In Jericho, visit the ruins of the ancient city that was conquered by Joshua (Josh. 6:30). From Jericho, you can see the traditional site of the temptation of Jesus (Matt. 4:1-11).

Overnight in the Dead Sea area.

## 05 Nov (M) – Masada / Qumran / Bethlehem

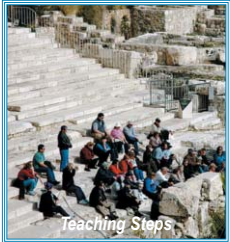
Enjoy a visit to **Masada**, the spectacular mountaintop fortress built by Herod and famous as the last stronghold of the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans.

Ride the cable car to the top to explore the fortress. Peer down upon the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. On the way back to Jerusalem, stop at the Shores of the Dead Sea, lowest spot on earth, where those who desire may take a quick dip in the Dead Sea. Walk the remains of an ancient community near the shores of the Dead Sea at **Qumran**. In the caves near here, Bedouins discovered what became known as the Dead Sea Scrolls. Cross the border into **Bethlehem**, the birthplace of Jesus (Luke 2). Enter the **Church of the Nativity**, the oldest continuously functioning church in the world. See the cave where tradition holds Jesus was born. Look out on the **Shepherd's Fields**, where angels spread the Good News. Enjoy dinner and overnight in Bethlehem. This evening, we'll meet with local Arab Christians.



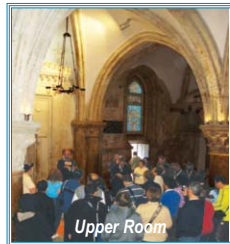
**06 Nov (T) – Temple Mount / Southern Steps / Western Wall / Jewish Quarter / Cardo / City of David Excavations / Pool of Siloam / St. Peter in Gallicantu Church / Upper Room**

See the **Temple Mount**, once the site of the Temple of Solomon. Visit the **Davidson Center** and the **Southern Wall Excavations** including the



**Teaching Steps** and the **Western Wall**. Walk the Jewish Quarter and take time to visit the **Cardo**, a 2,000 year old market with shops old and new. Wander the excavations of the City of David. Walk the steps to the **Pool of Siloam**, recently uncovered at the foot

of the City. See some of the ancient rooms of **Caiaphas' the High Priest's house** beneath the **Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu**. Here Jesus was held overnight before His crucifixion (Luke 22). Stand in the **Upper Room**, near the traditional site of the Last Supper (Mark 14). Check into your Jerusalem hotel for dinner and overnight. This evening, meet with a Jewish Rabbi.



**07 Nov (W) – Mount of Olives / Gethsemane / Church of All Nations / Kidron Valley / Pools at Bethesda / St. Anne's Church / Via Dolorosa / Lithostratos / Church of the Holy Sepulchre / Arab Souk**

Stand atop the **Mount of Olives** as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem. Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives (Acts 1: 9-12). Walk the **Palm Sunday Road**, down the Mt.



of Olives, to the **Garden of Gethsemane**. Pray there amongst Olive Trees in the Kidron Valley across from the walls of Jerusalem, where so much Biblical history has played out. Next to the Garden of Gethsemane is the **Church of All**

**Nations**. In the courtyard are Olive Trees whose roots date back to before the time of Christ. Inside the church is the stone where tradition holds Jesus prayed the night before His crucifixion. View the **Pool of Bethesda** (John

5: 1-31) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle.

Visit **Herod's Antonia Fortress** where Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23: 1-11). Lift your voice in song in the acoustically beautiful **Church of St. Anne**. Walk the **Via Dolorosa**, "the Way of the Cross,". Visit the **Lithostratos** at the **Convent of the Sisters of Zion**. This area of pavement constructed with large slabs is associated with the condemnation of Jesus by Pilate.

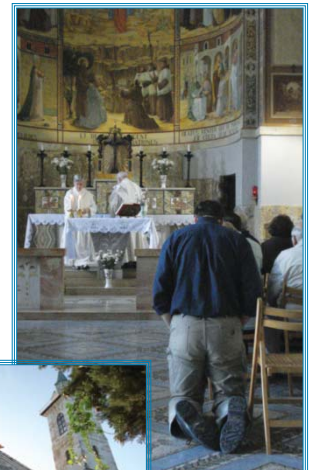
(John 19) The pavement also has a Roman "King's Game" board carved to use for a dice game in to it that recalls the casting of lots for Jesus' clothing after his crucifixion (John 19). Stand in reverence at the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**. Spend time exploring the shops of the Arab Souk (market) before heading to the hotel for dinner and overnight. This evening, meet with a representative for Bridges for Peace after dinner.



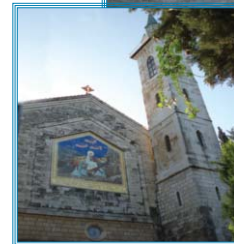
**08 Nov (H) – Garden Tomb / Ein Karem / Emmaus / Valley of Elah / Tel Aviv**

Visit and worship at the **Garden Tomb**, possible site of the garden of Joseph of Arimathea and experience the reality of the Resurrection.

Continue to **Ein Karem**, traditionally known as the birthplace of John the Baptist, and where tradition holds that Mary journeyed to share with Elizabeth her good news (Luke 1: 39-48). Walk the



**Emmaus Road** where Jesus appeared to two travelers on the evening of the resurrection (Luke 24:13-35). We'll journey



through the **Valley of Elah** where David defeated Goliath (I Samuel 17). Enjoy dinner and rest before your transfer to the airport for your return flight home.
